



If you pay someone to take away your household rubbish or unwanted items, you must check that they are a registered waste carrier. If you don't, you can now be fined £300 or receive an unlimited fine if prosecuted.

To meet your **Householder Waste Duty of Care** you must:

1. Check with Natural Resources Wales that the person or company you are using is registered. You can do this online at naturalresources.wales/checkWaste or by calling **03000 653000** (open 8am – 6pm weekdays, charged at national rate).
2. Ask where your waste is going.


We also recommend that you:

- Record any checks that you make, including the operator's name & registration number
- Keep a receipt which includes a description of the waste and company used
- Record details of the business or vehicle (registration, make, model, colour)
