

If you pay someone to take away your household rubbish or unwanted items, you must check that they are a registered waste carrier. If you don't, you can now be fined £300 or receive an unlimited fine if prosecuted.

## To meet your Householder Waste Duty of Care you must:

- Check with Natural Resources Wales that the person or company you are using is registered. You can do this online at naturalresources.wales/checkWaste or by calling 03000 653000 (open 8am – 6pm weekdays, charged at national rate).
- 2. Ask where your waste is going.

## We also recommend that you:

- Record any checks that you make, including the operator's name & registration number
- Keep a receipt which includes a description of the waste and company used
- Record details of the business or vehicle (registration, make, model, colour)
